[QUICK REF] Light Painting/ Long Exposure

Photographing a moving light source in an otherwise dark photo

Light Painting/Long Exposure Photography

Ingredients:

- Fixed lens with wide aperture
- Time Value Mode (S or Tv) (or Manual)
- Tripod
- Light source

Use a camera with longest Time Value setting and/or bulb shutter settings (Manual). Most DSLRs have this feature and will allow you to have the shutter open for as long as you like. If you don't have this available you'll need to find your camera's longest shutter setting to capture the "light painting" produced with your light source. Photograph shown = sparklers
